On behalf of Caritas Diocese of Salford, I wish to acknowledge and thank you for taking the time to appeal for and collect the food items you delivered to our Lalley Centre food pantry and allotment. Please know that this practical support will be appreciated by someone experiencing poverty and homelessness in Manchester / Bury.

At the last count in March 2025, there were 386 people sleeping rough and 6,042 households in temporary accommodation, including 8,855 children (that's roughly a thousand more children than the same period last year!) And, there are thousands more at risk of losing their home, due to the financial difficulties they are experiencing.

Please pass on our heartfelt thanks to all the staff and pupils at St Thomas More RC Primary for their continued generosity and support. We never take it for granted.

#### **Medication Policy**

In line with the advice from Health and Safety and following DfE guidelines the schools medication Policy has been updated. It is attached to the email with the newsletter, but I would like to draw particular attention to the section below.

Receiving non - prescribed medication from parents

As a school we are committed the Department of Education (DfE) drive to improve attendance and appreciate that sometimes pupils may need liquid paracetamol (e.g. Calpol) or liquid ibuprofen (e.g. Nurofen) or anti-histamine (e.g. Piriton).

Non -prescribed medication will not be administered without a Parental consent form being completed – **VERBAL CONSENT OVER THE PHONE WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED** 

If your child requires non-prescribed medication, you must provide it with their name clearly labelled. Unused medication will be returned to parents.


