Receiving non - prescribed medication from parents

As a school we are committed the Department of Education (DfE) drive to improve attendance and appreciate that sometimes pupils may need liquid paracetamol (e.g. Calpol) or liquid ibuprofen (e.g. Nurofen) or anti-histamine (e.g. Piriton).

Non -prescribed medication will not be administered without a Parental consent form being completed –

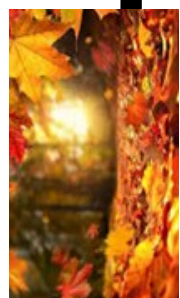
VERBAL CONSENT OVER THE PHONE WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED
