# **Education Welfare Officer (EWO)**

We have developed a fantastic working relationship with our LA officer and she is committed to supporting our school community with the government's attendance agenda.

Firstly a reminder that the school gates open at 8:30am, the first bell is at 8:40am and the second bell is 8:50am, this is when children should be in class ready to start the day. The gates are closed at 8:50am, if arriving after this time children should enter via the Main Entrance and be signed in on Inventry, the information is then fed into the registers. Lateness on the registers is also picked up by the officer and can be classed as unauthorised which if regularly occurs can incur an LA penalty notice fine.

As such we are adapting our routines regarding absences for medical appointments and illnesses. If your child has an appointment we will require sight of an appointment card or a confirmation text from NHS at the office, this will then be recorded as such on the register, if no confirmation is forthcoming it will be classed as unauthorised.

If your child is ill, please ring school and report on the absence phone line with the name of the child, class and illness/ absence. If an absence is prolonged please keep school informed regarding the illness, these will be authorised. If there are persistent illnesses of more than 3 days then we have will require some form of medical proof, if not provided these will be classed as unauthorised. If there are 20 sessions (10 days) of unauthorised absence in a 12 week period this can incur an LA penalty notice fine.

I have explained previously holidays during term time require the completion of a holiday form, which explains that such a holiday could incur a penalty notice fine actioned by the LA.

I appreciate your support working together to improve attendance in our school.



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#### Lunchtimes

All children in Reception to Year 2 are eligible for a free school meal, this is called Universal Free School meals, if you want your child to have a hot meal please take a look at the website for the menus from Mellors.

Reminder that all dinner monies are to be paid weekly for any children in Key Stage 2 (year 3-6), this is essential as we are charged weekly by Mellors.

We are increasingly concerned by the waste form children bringing packed lunches to school, there are a number of children who are either throwing their lunches away. Obviously it is important for you, as parents, to know what your child has eaten, therefore the children will be bringing any leftover food home for you to monitor.
