Packed Lunches:

- If your child is attending the full day session, you will need to provide a packed lunch.
- We find that around 4 items in their packed lunch is an appropriate amount for them to eat during their lunch break.
- Pléase ensure that packed lunches are in a labelled lunch bag and include a drink.
- We are a NUT FREE school and request that items sent in lunch bags are free from nuts.

Snacks:

- A drink of milk or water and a snack is available during the course of the morning for the children
- Weekly snack money donation = £1





- Information about the 30 hour eligibility codes were included in the pack that was posted out in May.
- Please follow the advice and please let us know as soon as you have the eligibility code.





- An opportunity for you and your child to meet the team, their new friends and explore the environment.
- Stay and Play sessions Wednesday 6th and Thursday 7th September 2023.
- Each session is for one hour and we are currently able to allow <u>one</u> parent per child to stay for the duration of the sessions.
- All dates and your allocated time slot are included in the pack that you have received.

Morning 'drop off'

- School gates open from 8:30am, please 'drop off' your child off at the Nursery building.
- We encourage the children to enter the building and staff will assist as the children 'hang up' their belongings on their coat pegs.
- When 'dropping off' please ensure that the entrance door remains clear for all children to enter the building safely. Our Nursery cloakroom is quite 'snug' and staff will be present to assist the children as they enter.



Afternoon 'pick up'

- School gates open from 3pm, please queue and collect your child from the Nursery building – along the fence near the large green containers.
- When collecting your child, please ensure that the exit door remains clear for all children to exit the building safely.
- When collecting your child, the member of the team 'on the door' will ask who you have come to collect, please state your child's name clearly. Your child will be then called from class to exit school.
- Please let us know if there will be a different collection arrangement for your child – e.g. the adult collecting your child from school.
- We release all Nursery children from the same exit, so please bear with us as we safely release all children from class.

Preparing for Nursery checklist



Can your child:

- Tidy up toys and put things away?
- Wait for their turn when an adult is busy with others?
- Comply with reasonable adult requests promptly and appropriately?
