### Outdoor Provision



- We access our outdoor provision throughout the day which allows the children to experience all weather conditions!
- Please ensure that your child has 'weather appropriate clothing' each day



### Packed Lunches and Snacks



#### Packed Lunches:

- If your child is attending the full day session, you will need to provide a packed lunch.
- We find that around 4 items in their packed lunch is an appropriate amount for them to eat during their lunch break.
- Please ensure that packed lunches are in a labelled lunch bag and include a drink.
- We are a NUT FREE school and request that items sent in lunch bags are free from nuts.

#### Snacks:

- A drink of milk or water and a snack is available during the course of the morning for the children
- Weekly snack money = £1

- This is an informal discussion and an opportunity to meet with you and your child.
- We are currently trying to source software that will enable us to undertake a 'virtual' home visit. We will be in touch with further details if this is possible.

## Stay and Play sessions



- An opportunity for you and your child to meet the team, their new friends and explore the environment.
- Stay and Play sessions Monday 6<sup>th</sup> and Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> September 2021.
- Each session is for one hour and we are currently able to allow <u>one</u> parent per child to stay for the duration of the sessions.
- All dates and your allocated time slot are included in the pack that you have received.

# Starting school in September 'Drop off and collect'



- In line with the current COVID-19 guidance and our school Risk Assessment, there is currently a 'one way' system around the school site.
- Presently, we enter the school site via the green gates near the staff car park. From here you will walk ahead to the main playground and then turn left to access the Nursery building. Once you have 'dropped off' your child, you will then walk down towards the visitor car park to leave the school site.
- We ask that one adult accompanies their child to 'drop off' and 'collect' their child each day and that masks are worn by adults (unless exempt).
- After we have completed our Stay and Play sessions and the 'staggered' timetable, our school gates and Nursery door opens at 8:30am, children can be 'dropped off' from this time and the gates close at 8:50am. This is to 'ease the flow' of people on the school site.
- At the end of the day, our school gates open at 2:50pm and children in the Nursery can be collected from this time.

- Tidy up toys and put things away?
- Wait for their turn when an adult is busy with others?
- Comply with reasonable adult requests promptly and appropriately?
