Zoom

- The children will be taught via zoom throughout the week.
- At the moment this will be alternate days for Maths and English and once per week for class read.

- Due to clashes with other key stages we have limited the number of zooms at the moment, this may change as we continue throughout the weeks.
- All of our zooms are being held daily at 10am (except Friday)

Zoom rules

- Muted until told
- Good to be green behaviour
- Adult in the background
- No photography or recording of zoom
- Name of child to allow entry to meeting.
- Children should be seated in a shared area
- Children will need to be sat with a pencil and paper in each lesson.
- Maths work should be completed in their maths homework books, English in English homework books.

Google Classroom continued...

- As you can see on the timetable lots of the work, activities and links will be posted on Google Classroom
- We will be uploading the work daily rather than weekly as we hope this will be easier for the children to access and for the staff to keep track of.
- ALL members of the LKS2 team have access to all classes, therefore a member of staff, other than the class teacher, may comment on children's work.
- Children can use Google Classroom to communicate with each other and can comment ***politely*** on each other's work (they are used to doing this in class anyway)
- Do not feel that you must upload every piece of work the children complete – Friday's show and share will allow children to showcase their work

Pre-recorded lessons

- Some lessons the teachers will have pre-recorded in school, these will be uploaded onto Google Classroom on the appropriate day.
- Children should watch the videos and engage with any tasks set.



YouTube and Oak Academy

- There will be links to both YouTube and Oak Academy to support learning, these links will be posted on Google Classroom as well as on the weekly timetable.
- Also BBC Bitesize are running an online learning programme during school closures
- Don't forget to log onto TTRS as much as possible
- Please read daily and fill in homework diaries



Class Dojo



- We will continue to use Class Dojo to award the children dojo points for their learning.
- We will award dojos for participation in zoom sessions (a second member of staff will be part of the zoom and can award points)
- They will also be awarded for sharing work on our show and share zoom on Friday mornings.
- There are sometimes discrepancies between the dojos in school and those shown at home, we are not sure why this is at the moment.
- Parents can continue to use class dojo to message teachers but please allow time for us to message back.
