Maths - Year 5 and 6 objectives:

The topics we are covering this term are:

Fractions, decimals and percentages, Ratio and proportion, Area, perimeter and volume

Statistics; line graphs, pie charts, circles and The mean.

Properties of shape including; angles, angles in triangles, quadrilaterals and regular polygons and nets of 3d shapes.

Reasoning and problem solving activities linked to all topics.

Times Tables up to 12 times tables.

Topic - Our topic during the Summer Term, we are focusing on 'Crime and Punishment.'

We will be looking at how punishments changed over periods of history and focusing on how changes have impacted us in modern times. We will be debating certain punishments and comparing past punishments to those in modern Britain.

This will be linked to our English text: The Highwayman which will also link to our Art and DT work.

English

Text focus: The Highwayman Writing focus: persuasive letter writing, wanted posters, third person narrative, love letters, monologue, feelings journey

Text Focus: The Barnabus Project **Writing Focus:** Persuasive advert, formal scientific report, persuasive speeches, action writing, post cards.

Reading: guided reading 30 minutes per day, **Library Book:** independent read daily.

Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar: a range of grammar and punctuation embedded daily, spelling taught as regular sessions.

Science – Topic: Evolution and inheritance

Key objectives; to understand how animals have adapted over time and study different theories of evolution and to use fossil records to prove theories

Science - Topic: Growing up and growing old.

Key objectives; We will be learning: To describe the stages of human development, to present data to show understanding of how babies grow and develop, to describe the changes in human development up to old age, to be able to find information and answer questions about what happens in old age, to write an information text explaining the changes about human development, to identify and explain irreversible and chemical changes and to explain how materials are changed when mixed together.

Religion Topic: Transformations- The Holy Sprit

Key objectives; To learn and understand about the Holy Spirit and how it transformed the apostles and disciples of Jesus and how it can transform us all.

Topic: Freedom and Responsibility

Key objectives: To explore reconciliation and how we repair friendships and relationships, to find out about Gods rules for living freely and taking responsibility and to know and understand the ten commandments

RHE- (Relationship and Health Education) Topic – Me, My Body, My Health

Children will learn that celebrating differences between people is enriching to a community and know that their self-confidence should arise from being loved by God. They will learn about the physical changes that boys and girls go through during puberty and how they should respect and take care of their bodies as gifts from God.
