

Maths – Year 5 and 6 objectives:

The topics we are covering this term are:

Place value of numbers up to 100,000

Rounding numbers to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000, within 100,000,

Comparing numbers,

Using the inverse operation,

Using Roman Numerals,

Negative numbers and the four operations.

Science – Our topic for this half term is, ‘Out of this World,’ focusing on Earth and space.

Describe the movement of the Earth and other planets relative to the sun in the solar system.

Describe the movement of the moon relative to the Earth.

Describe the sun, Earth and moon as approximately spherical bodies.

Use the idea of the Earth’s rotation to explain day and night and the apparent movement of the sun across the sky.

Religion - Our religion topic this half term focuses on, ‘What makes us unique?’

Key objectives:

To explore the meaning of and know that we are all part of God’s family.

To explore a deeper awareness of the talents and qualities we hold.

To understand that the qualities that make us holy people.

To develop our understanding of the qualities God gives us and wants us to develop.

To think about how we can use our qualities for the service of others.

To know that God helps us in hard times and is there for us.

Topic – Our topic this term is focusing on an ancient civilisation, the Egyptians.

Our key concepts are:

To understand where Egypt is.

To understand that the Egyptians worshipped many Gods.

To understand that the Egyptians believed that all people had a soul.

To learn about all the different jobs that the Ancient Egyptians had.

To understand what the ancient Egyptians believed to happen after death.

To understand the process of mummification.

To understand how and why the Egyptians built the Pyramids.

To understand what survived from ancient Egypt.

English -

Text focus: Egyptian Cinderella, The Story of Tutankhamun

Writing focus: first person diary writing, character description, dialogue, instructions for mummification and recount writing.

Reading: guided reading 30 minutes per day, class read book daily.

Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar: a range of grammar and punctuation embedded daily, spelling taught as regular sessions.
