Dear Parents & Carers,

It is important that we take time to reflect on what has been achieved in such an uncertain year. April marked the first year of our school being a primary. As I am sure you know, in April 2020, St. Ursula's Catholic Infant and St. Ursula's Catholic Junior schools amalgamated to become St. Ursula's Catholic Primary School. The two schools amalgamated to provide our pupils with a seamless transition through school, and for parents to not have to apply for a place at the Junior School.

A lot has changed over the past year and as one school, pupils are now benefiting from consistent education plans, curriculums, and policies. There are still developments taking place behind the scenes to further support the development of St. Ursula's in working as a Primary School. One of these developments is the reorganising of our two school offices. As in other Primary schools, St. Ursula's now has one main office rather than two offices. With changes to our offices there come new systems and procedures. Please make yourselves familiar with the key changes below:

- The St. Ursula's Catholic Primary School Office is located in the EYFS/KS1 block. There is no longer an office in the Key Stage 2 building.
- All communication to and from the school will go through this office. Contact details remain the same and can be found on the school website. New caller options have been created for when parents/carers call the school office to ensure they are able talk to the required member of staff.
- Pupils will continue to enter and exit school through the usual gates; however, any pupils arriving late will now need to enter through the EYFS/KS1 gate to ensure they have been signed in at the office. Parents/carers who are late for collection must also report to this office.

To support these changes, new signs will be installed and current ones updated. If you have any questions regarding these changes please do not hesitate to contact the school
