## Dear Parents/Carers,

The first 3 weeks have passed by in a flash and I'm happy to say that our pupils have settled back into school life brilliantly! Once again, thank you for your understanding and support in implementing the changes we have had to make this week.

I'm pleased to announce that as of next Thursday (1st October), the school kitchen will resume serving hot meals for lunch. To celebrate the return of hot meals, we will be providing a special menu

for pupils to choose from. KS2 Pupils will order their lunches as usual. Information on ordering KS1/EYFS lunches will be sent out in due course.

In other news, the School Governors have approved my plan to redevelop the outside learning areas for Nursery and Reception. Since the start of September, myself and the EYFS team have been working with three companies to improve our Early Year's provision. These areas have not been updated for some time and are in need of some TLC. After reviewing the plans and costs, Governors have given the green light for work to begin. Work on these areas will hopefully commence in the coming weeks.

This redevelopment signals the beginning of my improvement plan for St Ursula's Catholic Primary School. I am extremely excited about this development as this will have a significantly positive impact on the quality of education of our pupils as they begin their journey as a St Ursula's pupil.

A message from ... Mrs Bell & Mrs Walsh

We are the Home School Support Workers for St Ursula's Catholic Primary School. Part of our role is to work closely with families and provide support, where possible. One way of helping our families is ensuring they are aware of the support that is available, such as Pupil Premium funding.



If your child is eligible for Pupil Premium, St Ur-

sula's will receive a substantial amount of extra funding. We receive an extra £1,320.00 per pupil each year, which would be invested in your child's learning. A simple check can be quickly completed at school to see if your child is eligible. Please email or call the School Office if you would like to check if your child is eligible.
