School Trip – Bedford Park

We are pleased to inform you that we have arranged a trip to Bedford Park for Reception for Thursday 27th March 2025. This trip links to Reception's Spring Topics of Spring and our Summer term topic of Minibeasts. This will be an excellent opportunity for the children to build upon their prior learning.
