Reminders

*Nail varnish:

Nail varnish should not be worn to school. If your child wears nail varnish over the weekend or for a special occasion, then please make sure that it is removed **before** they come to school in line with our School Policy.

*Book bags / Rucksacks:

Children in EYFS and KS1 should only be coming to school with book bags. These are used to store their reading books, reading records and any letters from school. This also ensures that there is adequate space in the cloakroom area for everyone to store their coats and book bags.

Children in KS2 should only be coming into school with a small rucksack – with enough room for their reading books, reading records and homework.

We are having a number of children bringing in massive bags and bags on wheels – these are not allowed and are not necessary in Primary School.

*Hair:

As per our School Policy, children should not have multi-coloured beads or strands in their hair. Hair that is to the shoulder or longer should be tied up (regardless of gender).

*Birthdays:

As a school we are happy to celebrate our children's birthdays but we ask that if you are sending sweets in for the whole class, then please only send in Haribo or a sweet that all children can eat – they must be Nut free. We will not be handing out party bags or tubs of chocolates due to allergies.

Year 5

Space Dome

The educational objectives for the Space Dome are:

Year 6

Homework

We have noticed a decline in the number of pupils completing their weekly homework. The homework set in Year 6 is a vital tool to support both our learning in class as well as our revision for our SATs exams. The Year 6 team are currently working tirelessly to support the children through our intervention groups and extra support sessions. However, it is imperative that the children are taking ownership of their learning and continuing their work at home.

Homework should be handed in by Thursday the latest, to allow staff to mark it to be given back out on Friday; if this homework is not handed in on, time staff are unable to check it.
