Nursery to Year 6 – PTA Christmas 4 Schools Card Design



Year 3

Year 4

Next Wednesday (20th November), the children in year 4 will be beginning to make their own pneumatic toy dinosaurs!

Power2Inspire

Our children are lucky enough to be taking part in this unique and inspiring day on Friday 29th November 2024.

The day will begin with an assembly on "Overcoming Barriers" and aims to inspire questions from all ages. Then the pupils are introduced to adapted games including boccia, new age kurling, goalball, and sitting volleyball. Emphasis is placed on teamwork, communication, kindness, respect, resilience and perseverance. All participants receive a certificate and are given an opportunity to raise further questions, and are challenged to recall what they have learned.

This experience will take place during the school day, so please ensure that your child is dropped off and picked up at the normal times. The cost of this experience will be £9 per child. Payments should be made on SchoolGateway by Friday 22nd November 2024.
