Our children are lucky enough to be taking part in this unique and inspiring day on Friday 29th November 2024.

The day will begin with an assembly on "Overcoming Barriers" and aims to inspire questions from all ages. Then the pupils are introduced to adapted games including boccia, new age kurling, goalball, and sitting volleyball. Emphasis is placed on teamwork, communication, kindness, respect, resilience and perseverance.
