The School Day

Below is an outline of what we will be learning with the children in this Autumn term:

Subject	Spring Term 1	Spring Term 2
English	Fiction work will be based on the stories of 'Whatever Next', 'How To Catch A Star', 'Hansel and Gretel'. Non-fiction work will be based on famous explorers Neil Armstrong and Christopher Columbus.	Fiction work will be based on the stories of 'Paddington' and 'Ron the Royal Guard'. Non-fiction work will be based on 'The Magic London Bus'.
Maths	Place Value of numbers within 50. Addition and Subtraction within 20.	Measurement, length and height, weight and volume. Place value within 50 – including learning multiples of 2's, 5's and 10's.
RE	Special People - Learning about who are the special people within our Church Community. Learning about the presentation of Jesus at the temple.	Meals - Learning about special meals and the special meal we have on a Sunday when we gather as a church family.
Topic	What is an explorer? - Learning about famous explorers from the past - including Neil Armstrong and Christopher Columbus. We will also be designing and making a rocket or a boat.	What is the United Kingdom? We will be learning about the four countries in the UK. We will learn their names, capital cities and other important information about the countries.



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My Week at School - Each week you will be able to view information about your child's 'Week at School'. This will be sent out via Schoolcomms. The document will inform you each week of the different learning activities the children will be doing in Year 1.

Reading

Our expectations are for children to read a least 5 times each week. When the children have read a set amount of times they will receive a certificate in Achievement Assembly.
