Happy New Year! We hope you had a great Christmas and are looking forward to the term ahead. We have been working hard to plan lots of interesting lessons and activities for you. Here is an overview of what will be happening this term.

Our Topics this Term

English: We will be reading The Iron Man (by Ted Hughes) and Cloud Tea Monkeys (by Elspeth Graham and Mal Peet).

Maths: Multiplication, division and money.

CLC: For the first half of the Spring term we will be looking at key events and individuals that have helped shape the world – Homan Walsh and how he used a kite to help build the Niagara Falls Bridge. We will also be using Art and DT skills to design and create a kite, as well as learning to sing a song from Mary Poppins.

In the second half of the Spring term we will be locating and studying oceans and mountains across the world. We will be using atlases and online resources to further the children's understanding in this area. In addition to this, we will also be developing our art skills by creating collages of mountains.

R.E: Journeys, Listening & Sharing and Giving All

Science: We will be learning about Light and Dark. In Spring 2, we will then be moving on to Forces and Magnets.

This helps them build their own vocabulary and improve their understanding when they read, which is vital as they continue to develop their narrative writing. Reading records need to be signed and brought into school daily.
