Key Job



Reception children are encouraged to take responsibility for their own learning and are given a Key Jobs to complete

each day. The children all have their own hook, so that when they have completed a job the key is placed onto it. The children are responsible for choosing when to complete their key job but must be completed by the end of the day.

Key jobs can include:

- Pencil play sheets
- Drawing a picture
- Retelling a story
- Making something in the creative areas of our classroom
- Taking on a role
- Completing a maths challenge

We encourage the children to talk about what they have done in their challenges before they receive their key.
