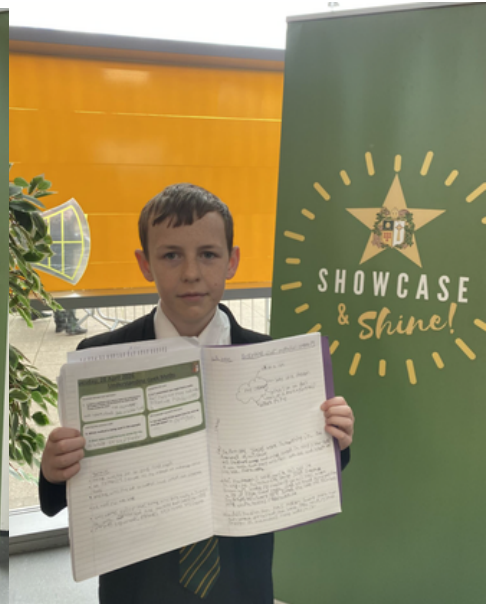
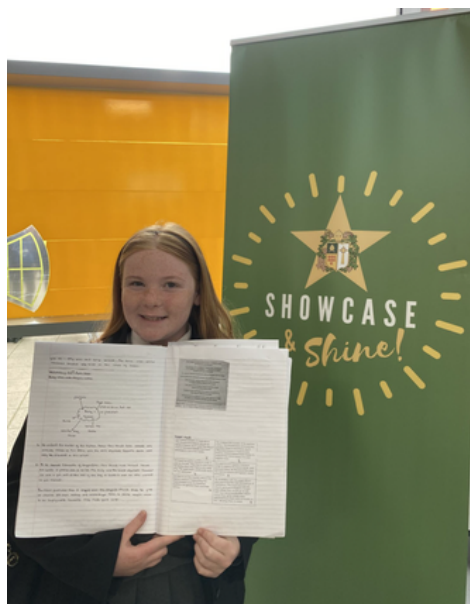

All of the work we saw was of such high quality and it was brilliant to hear all about their class work and how proud they are of their progress over the year.

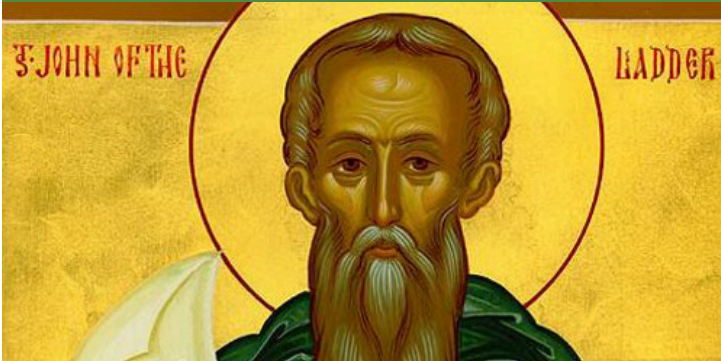




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FAITH FOCUS
