I hope this letter finds you well. We would like to inform you that the Year 11 and 13 Preliminary Examinations will be taking place from the **Monday 20**th **October to Friday 7**th **November**. These exams are a crucial part of our pupils' academic journey, as they offer an opportunity to prepare for their external examinations.

Please note the following important details:

- Dates of Exams: 20th October- 7th November
- **Exam Timetable**: A printed copy of the exam timetable has been provided to the pupils. Pupils are encouraged to review this carefully and ensure they are fully prepared for each exam. A copy of the prelim exam timetable can be found on the school website.
- **Preparation**: All pupils have been supported in preparation for these exams through our performance strand. We will continue to offer revision sessions at lunchtime and after school, during the examination window. Pupils are encouraged to attend these to further support their preparation.
- What to Bring- Pupils should ensure they bring the following items to their exams:
 - Stationery [black pen, pencil, ruler as required]
 - A clear water bottle [free of labels]
- Attendance- It is essential that pupils attend each exam as scheduled. If your child is unable to attend for any reason, please inform the school as soon as possible so we can make appropriate arrangements.
- **JCQ Regulations**: Pupils should wear their full school uniform for exams. Pupils are not permitted to have any electronic devices, a watch or notes in their possession including in their blazer pockets. For further information please see the JCQ regulations on our school website.
