Following a recent Health and Safety visit, we are once again asking for your continued cooperation in ensuring the safety and accessibility of our school environment during drop-off and pick-up times.

Please be mindful when parking near the school. We kindly ask that you:

- **Avoid blocking driveways, pavements, or access points**, even briefly. These areas are essential for residents, pedestrians, and emergency services.
- **Consider parking a little further away** and walking the final stretch. This not only eases congestion around the school gates but also contributes to a calmer, safer atmosphere for our children.
- Respect our neighbours by ensuring their driveways and paths remain clear and accessible at all times.
- Keep pavements clear for families with pushchairs, wheelchair users, and children walking to school.

We understand that mornings can be busy and time is often tight, but small acts of consideration make a big difference to the wellbeing of our whole community.
