In English we will continue to work towards improving our reading and writing skills through a range of interesting texts.

Spelling, punctuation and grammar skills will be practiced regularly and will develop through whole class activities, group work, shared sessions and independent learning.

We will be covering a range of reading and writing genres including poetry.



In Mathematics, we will be addressing place value problems, addition & subtraction and multiplication & division. We will continue to practice our mental maths skills including the use of times tables to solve problems. Children are encouraged to use Times Tables Rock Stars at home and in school to improve their multiplication skills.



As Geographers we will be investigating Seaside Rocks; exploring coastal locations in the UK and beyond! We will look at the cause, effect and response to erosion of coastlines and understand how we can respond to keep our coastlines safe and healthy.

To enhance our exploration of rocks, our Science topic focuses on the properties of different types of rock and how they are formed and how they are formed, and will learn about the contribution of Mary Anning, palaeontologist.



As Historians we will be going back to the Stone Age and travelling through the Bronze Age, to the Iron Age. We will recognise connections, contrasts and trends over time and think about the cause and effects of past events. Children will be given the opportunity to put forth their views and opinions through a range of activities including class discussion and debate.

As Artists we will be comparing artists, and taking inspiration from their works and methods to create our own pieces of art. We will use a range of mediums including acrylic paint and watercolours.
