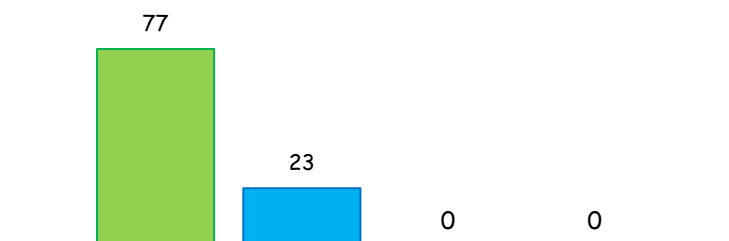

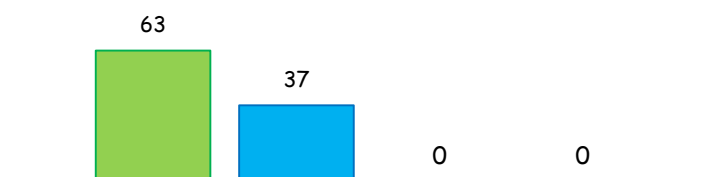

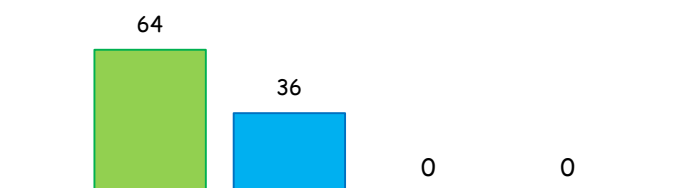
Q1. My child is happy at this school



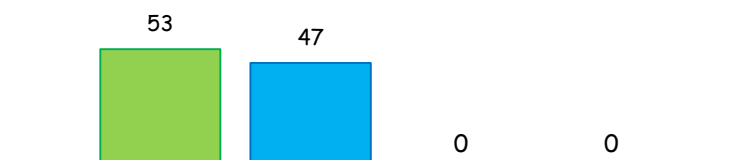
Q2. My child makes good progress at this school



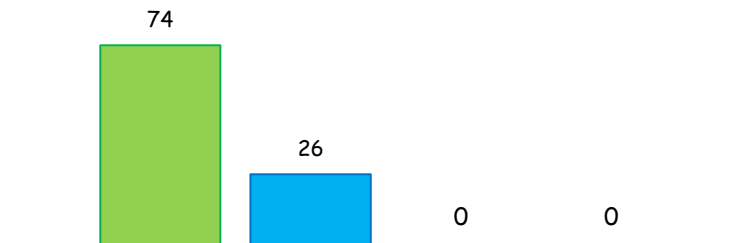
Q3. My child is taught well at this school



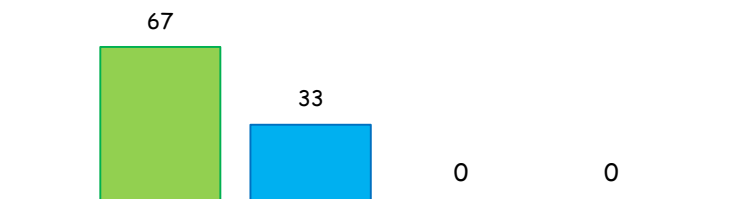
Q4. The school makes sure its pupils are well behaved



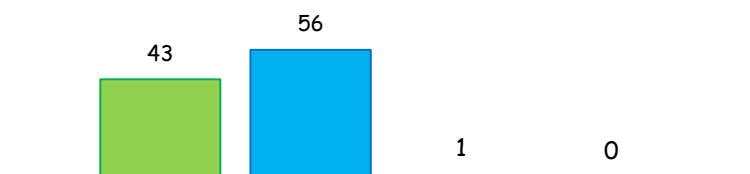
Q5. My child feels safe at this school



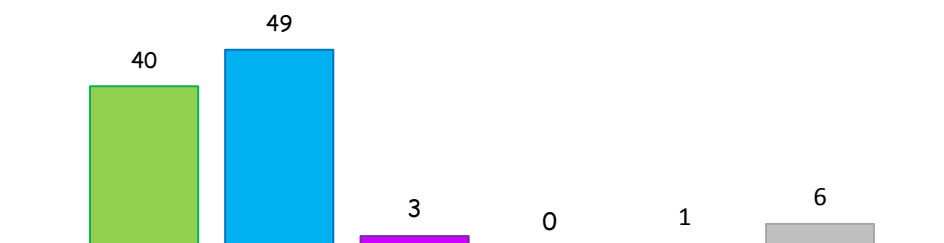
Q6. My child is well looked after at this school



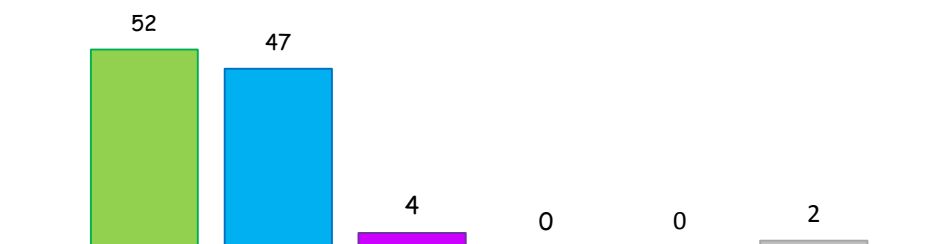
Q7. My child receives appropriate homework for their age

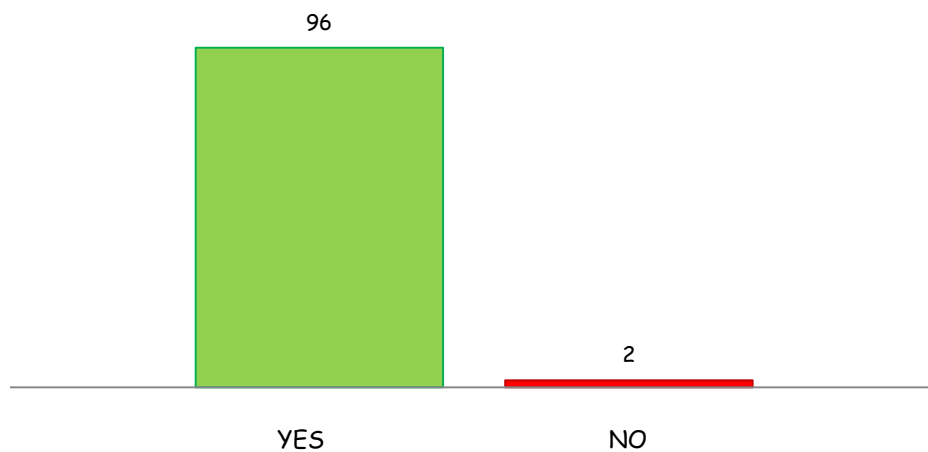

Parent Questionnaire - responses gathered in October 2013

Summary of results

- The questionnaire gathered 90 responses from Stakesby families.
- 20 responses (22%) marked all answers as "Strongly Agree"
- 86 responses would recommend the school to others (96%)
- Only 2 responses would not recommend the school.
- Seven questions in total were skipped.
- The most positive response indicated that 69 parents (77%) "Strongly Agree" that their child is happy.
- Many areas of the questionnaire indicated that 100% of parents "Strongly Agree" or "Agree" with the statements.
- 5 responses indicated that they had no knowledge of whether the school deals effectively with bullying at they had not experienced it.
- The overwhelming majority of responses indicated that the school is well led and managed. Only 4 responses indicated that they "Disagreed" with this statement. This was the same for receiving valuable information about children's progress.
- Only 1 response indicated that they disagreed with the statement: The school does not respond well to the concerns I raise.

Strengths

100% of responses agreed that:

- Their child is happy at school.
- Their child makes good progress at the school.
- Their child is taught well at the school.
- The school makes sure its pupils are well behaved.
- Their child feels safe at school.
- Their child is well looked after at school

Areas to investigate further/develop:

Statements that were disagreed with were:

- This school is well led and managed (4% disagreed)
- This school deals effectively with bullying (3%)
- I receive valuable information from the school about my child's progress (4% disagreed)
- This school responds well to any concerns I raise (1%)
