**Photograph consent forms** (new GDPR rules)-We recently sent photograph consent forms out to parents of all children. Unfortunately, despite reminders and additional sheets being sent out we still have a significant number of pupil forms not returned. As a result, pupils who have not returned their sheets will not be allowed to have photographs taken in school. This includes: having their pictures taken at sporting events such as the KS2 sports day; assemblies; class celebrations; trips, or when working in class to share their learning. If you have not returned your form please do so as soon as possible, if you have lost your form the school office staff will be happy to give you another one. *Please note we do not require permission for your child's photograph to be on our management system as we have legal basis for this.* 

**Newsletters-from September** we will no longer be sending home weekly paper newsletters. Newsletters will be posted on the school website, notice boards and will be emailed out to parents requesting them. If you are happy to receive the newsletter by email please return the attached slip. Please be aware that sometimes our newsletters contain marketing information such as: notices about the Parish Fair; Information about the new holiday and aftercare club; events at the high school etc.

**Sacramental Programme 2018-19.** This week, we have sent out letters from Father Glover to Catholic children in Year 3 for next year's Sacramental programme - leading to children receiving the sacrament of Holy Communion in June next year. If your child has not received a letter and/or they are in a different year group and you would like them to take part in the programme, please let the school office staff know and they will give you a form to complete. The Sacramental Programme is led by the parish and supported by the school and parents equally. Programme sessions are held on a Saturday afternoon followed with attendance at Mass the following day- parents are expected to attend the Masses with their child.

**Year 6 Residential** — **A Big Thank You** to Mrs Regan, Mrs Clegg, Mrs Butterfield and Mr Foster for taking the children on the residential. It is a big ask to ask staff to take pupils on a residential away from their families (it is not part of their teaching duties) and we are very lucky to have staff willing to do so. I know they appreciated the children's thank yous and those of some parents. The children's behaviour was excellent as usual and they represented the school in a positive manner-thank you children!

We will be sending out information for next year's Year 6 residential, hopefully before the summer holiday.
