Maths:

1 Kings 7:23

'And he made a molten sea, ten cubits from the one brim to the other: it was round all about, and his height was five cubits: and a line of thirty cubits did compass it round about.'

We want our children to have good mathematical skills so they are equipped with skills for the future, ever changing world. They are the future financiers, architects, maths teachers and so much more. We want them to be good with their finances, budgeting and empower them to help others too.

English:

Daniel 1:17

'To those four young men, God gave knowledge and understanding of literature and learning. And Daniel could understand the visions and dreams of all kinds.'

This is a reminder to us all that the study of literature enables our children to have a deeper understanding of themselves, others and the world around them. But it also empowers them to articulate their feelings, emotions and dreams as they grow culturally, intellectually, socially and spiritually into well rounded citizens of society.

We want our children to be literate and fluent in spoken language skills. For them to have excellent communication skills, read and understand the gospel, and spread the good news.

We want our children to have fantastic reading skills to continually learn. Uncover new ideas, philosophies etc.

Our children are the writers, script writers, film/ tv writers of the future and so much more

Science:

1 Corinthians 13:4-8

'Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. It is not rude, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres. Love never fails.'

At Anne's we believe that every child is born a scientist; asking why and how. Teachers share their passion of science and show students the beauty and importance of science in their everyday lives. Geography:

Psalm 24:1 'The earth is the Lord's, and everything in it, the world, and all who live in it.'

Geography promotes a love of the world and the stewardship of our planet. We believe that learning Geography enriches our understanding of the world and encourages people to take more care of it. This includes not only our natural world but all the people who live on earth. Through learning about how people live around the world we can develop our sense of empathy and compassion, as well as a love of travel and exploration to allow us to see new places and meet new people

By utilising and developing our God given gifts, nothing is impossible with God.

D&T:

Exodus 35:35 'The Lord has filled us with skill to carry out all the crafts of engraver, weaver and designer'

We all have God given talents that we can foster and nurture knowing God is by our side. God will provide us with solutions for every situation in life, because we know that Gods word is living and active and he will be by our side as develop our skills and crafts.

Our children are the future engineers, we want them to be equipped with ideas and skills of how things work, are made and used in the modern world that is continually developing.

Computing:

Deuteronomy 31:6 'Be strong and courageous. Do not be frightened, and do not be dismayed, for the LORD your God is with you wherever you go.'

We empower our children to be courageous enough to try new things – this is important in IT with the changing nature of technology

We want our children to be equipped for the jobs of the future. IT skills are essential. We want our children to have a good understanding of modern technology, a digital economy, as well as how to stay safe online in a world that is obsessed with social media and its influencers.

Latin: Acts 2:3-4 'All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit enabled them.'

Speaking in other tongues and the presence of the Holy Spirit helps the development of new languages and understanding of other cultures. Speaking and learning another language is a gift, just like speaking in tongues is a gift from the Holy Spirit.

We want our children to have good spoken language skills and learning Latin provides a good foundation in many other languages that they can go on to study in the future. Like the disciples, our children will be fluent to speak and share the good news/ Gospel to all corners of their world.

Music

Ephesians 5:19 Addressing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody to the Lord with your heart.'
