Concerns about a child should be logged promptly on CPOMS and a DSL alerted. If the concern is serious, a DSL (or Deputy) should be notified immediately.

### Children's Services

Where there is a concern about a child's safety, the law says we must protect that child. A referral from school to Children's Services means a Social Worker can work with us and the family to ascertain the best way to do this.
