How can we help people in 2021 affected by poverty?



### RESEARCH TASK:

Read the fact sheet and powerpoint slides. Can you find out anything else about 1904 and the St Joseph's Penny Appeal?

St Joseph's Penny still helps people today: families struggling to earn enough money to feed their children; older people who are lonely; homeless people without a warm, safe place to call their own.



### THINKING AND REFLECTION TASK:
