<u>Day</u>	<u>Date</u>	<u>Treat</u>	<u>Details</u>
1.	3 rd December	<u>Class Christmas Card</u>	Each child will pick a name from a hat and then make a card from the class for that person
2.	4 th December	<u>Christingle</u>	Children will need to bring in an orange to make a Christingle orange.
3.	7 th December	<u>Christmas Bauble and Bell Craft</u>	Children will make a small Christmas decoration in school.
4.	8 th December	<u>Extra Playtime</u>	An additional playtime in the afternoon.
5.	9 th December	<u>Hot Chocolate and Christmas Cake</u>	Children will be given a warm drink and choose a small cake.
6.	10 th December	<u>Christmas DVD</u>	The children will be allowed to watch a Christmas Film.
7.	11 th December	<u>Christmas Jumper Day</u>	Children can wear a Christmas Jumper. If possible they can bring in a donation for Manchester Children's Hospital but this is NOT compulsory.
8.	14 th December	<u>Crazy Christmas Hair</u>	Children can come to school wearing their hair in the craziest style they can think of.
9.	15 th December	<u>Make a Christmas Hat</u>	Children will make a Christmas hat in school, they can bring in items from home to decorate if they wish.
