

Dear Parents of Reception children,

I look forward to welcoming you back to school on **Friday 4<sup>th</sup> September 2020.**

For the first two days, all Reception children will attend school on a part time basis. This is to ensure that our youngest children have the opportunity to settle into school after having such a long time at home. Below is the timetable for the Reception classes for the first 2 days.

From Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup> September 2020, your child will attend school full time. Your child should arrive at the **main school entrance on Derbyshire Lane and 9:00am.**

The school day for Reception will **finish at 3:30pm.** Your child will leave school via the same entrance on Derbyshire Lane.

Children should attend school in full school uniform. Children can wear trainers (ideally with Velcro fastening) to school. Currently, PE kits are not required.

As your child is in Reception, they are entitled to Universal Free School Meals and will be provided with a school packed lunch. Please note, you will not be able to pre-order your child's meal for the first few days of term. It is very important to contact the school office with any allergies your child has so that we can order correctly for them. When you are provided with your child's School Grid account you will be able to pre-order the meals in advance. Further details and a menu will be sent to you as soon as these are available.

If you do not wish your child to receive a school packed lunch, please bring in a packed lunch from home. **Please be aware, we are not allowed food items containing nuts under any circumstances.**

All children must bring in a water bottle with their name clearly marked on it. All school equipment will be provided. Therefore, backpacks are NOT to be brought into school.

At school we will try to ensure social distancing. This is not possible at all times in the school day.

We look forward to seeing you and your child in September.
