

SCHOOL UNIFORM



Children identify with their school through the wearing of school uniform and parents are encouraged to ensure that their children are neatly presented in school uniform. The wearing of uniform also demands that outside school, children should behave in a fashion not likely to bring the school into disrepute.

EVERY ITEM OF UNIFORM AND ALL PERSONAL BELONGINGS MUST BE CLEARLY LABELLED. CHILDREN MUST TAKE RESPONSIBILITY FOR THEIR OWN THINGS.

WINTER UNIFORM (SEPTEMBER - EASTER)

SUMMER UNIFORM (AFTER EASTER)

SWIMMING FOR YEAR 3 Trunks for boys. Full costume for girls. A school swimming cap must be worn if your child has long hair.	
PE KIT (ALL PUPILS) Black shorts White t-shirt/ White Polo Shirt (Embroidered school badge optional) Purple sweatshirt - (Optional, cardigan or jumper may be worn if needed) Black Tracksuit Bottoms or Black Shorts (No sports labels, no leggings) Sensible trainers (Velcro for children who cannot tie their laces)	
SCHOOL BAGS - A school book bag is compulsory for Year Reception, Year 1 and Year 2. If your child is in the Juniors (Year 3, Year 4, Year 5 & Year 6) children may come to school with a suitable small bag/rucksack of their choice (no bigger than an A4 sheet of paper). Your child should also bring a water bottle with them every day (no screw tops) however, please do not put this in their rucksack as it may leak and damage their books.	
JEWELLERY - Apart from wrist watches, jewellery should not be worn. If a child's ears have been pierced, only small plain studs should be worn, but while participating in swimming or games/PE, the child will not be allowed to wear any type of ear adornment for safety reasons. Parents who allow their child to have an ear/s pierced during term time or immediately before the start of term, will effectively exclude that child from the curriculum activities identified above.	
HAIR - Hair must be neat and tidy. Long hair must be tied back. Extreme hairstyles are not permitted eg. Not patterned, stepped or shaved and cut no shorter than a number 2. Natural hair colour must be maintained and large decorative hair accessories are also unacceptable i.e. large bows, flowers, headbands with ears etc. No coloured hair braids/hair jewellery/hair extensions, mohicans etc.	
BIRTHDAYS - If a child's birthday lands on a school day only, they may wear their own clothes on that day.
