Daily Essentials

Please remind your child to only bring essential items to school in their small backpack:

P.E and Games

P.E will take place on Wednesdays (swimming) and Fridays. Children should come to school in their full P.E kits:

Reading

Please try to read with your child for 10 minutes per day and record it in your child's diary. You may wish to include comments and questions as this can help keep us informed of how your child is doing out of school.

Google Classroom will continue to be used this year for homework and sharing files, media and website. Please make sure you have accepted the invite to your child's new Google Classroom.

Medical

Please ensure that your child's medical information and emergency contact details are up to date and that any medications they may require are in school.

<u>Homework</u>

Weekly homework will consist of reading, spellings and timetables

- o Reading: 10 minutes daily and record in your child's diary.
- o Times Tables: 15 minutes on TTRS 3 times a week.
- o Spellings: Tests will take place on Thursdays and new spellings will be set on a Friday via SpellingFrame.
- o Fortnightly Homework: This will consist of a rotation between a Maths and English activity, and a Learning Journal style task related to our current learning. Children will have two weeks to complete this homework.
