

# Year 1 – Autumn Term Overview 2024–2025

## English

As part of our work this term, we will be looking at bridging from EYFS to Year 1 focusing on:

Poetry, songs and rhymes  
Stories with familiar settings  
Information Texts  
Repetitive Patterned Stories  
Range of Non-fiction texts  
Poems on a theme

We will be looking at grammatical concepts daily.

## RE

We will be looking at creation and covenant – how all that is made was created by God. We will also look at prophecy and promise – how God showed his love by sending Jesus, his Son.

## Maths

The children will look at place value within numbers to 10. We will use this knowledge for addition and subtraction within 10. The children will look at naming 2D and 3D shapes.

## History

We will be looking at toys from the past to answer our question 'Did Grandma and Grandad play on the Wii?'. We will focus on the events of The Gunpowder Plot and Remembrance Day that take place in Autumn.

## Science

We will be learning about different everyday materials, recognising the name of objects, the materials they are made from and some properties of these materials. Throughout the year we will be looking at the seasons and observe changes. We will also look at common plants and their structures.

## Art/DT

In Art we will be looking at art through spirals. In DT we will be looking at mechanisms to create a moving picture.

## PSHE

We will be looking at Health and Wellbeing:  
- Healthy lifestyles  
- Growing and Changing  
- Keeping Safe

## HSE

We will be thinking about how we are created and loved by God.

## Computing

In our computing lessons, we will be exploring the technology that is around us as well as thinking about digital citizenship/e-safety.

## Music

During Music we will be learning about the differences between pulse, rhythm and pitch and learning how to rap.

## PE

Games skills (outdoor) and Dance (indoor).
