

Year 1 – Summer Term Overview 2023-2024

English

As part of our work this term, we will be looking at building on the Year 1 objectives focusing on:

- Stories with Familiar Settings
- Non-fiction Booklets
- Stories to learn by heart
- Stories with fantasy settings
- Poems to learn by heart

We will be looking at grammatical concepts daily.

RE

We will be looking stories in Luke's Gospel and what happened at Pentecost. We will learn about traditions within Judaism.

Maths

The children will look at multiplication and division. We will use our knowledge to look at place value within 100. The children will look at fractions of shapes, quantities and numbers as well as money and time.

History

We will be looking at Florence Nightingale to answer our question 'How did Florence Nightingale make the world a better place?'.
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Geography

We will be answering the question 'What are seasons and why does the weather change?'.

Science

We will be learning about humans. Throughout the year we will be looking at the seasons and observe changes. We will also look at common plants and their structures.

Art/DT

In Art we will be looking at sunflowers and in DT a focus on food.

PSHE

We will be looking at Health and Wellbeing:

- rights and responsibilities
- taking care of the environment
- Money matters

HSE

We will be thinking about how we are created to love in the community.

Computing

In our computing lessons, we will be exploring computer science.

Music

During Music we will be learning about different styles of music and continuing to learn about pulse, pitch, rhythm and different instruments.

Games skills (outdoor) and athletics.
