

English

As part of our work this term, we will be looking at stories with familiar settings, instructions, poems, animal adventure stories and non-chronological reports. We will be looking at their key features and using these to write our own stories, instructions, poems, and reports. We will continue to work towards a cursive style of handwriting. We will also be thinking about grammatical concepts.

Maths

The children will read and write numbers to at least 100 and recognise the place value of each digit. They will learn to count in steps of 2s, 3s, 5s and 10s and use these to aid multiplication. Children will look at how we can partition numbers in different ways and be able to use number facts to solve problems. Children will calculate mathematical statements using repeated addition for multiplication. Children will learn to tell the time to five minutes and know the number of minutes in an hour and number of hours in a day. The children will identify and describe 2D and 3D shapes.

Topic

Our topic this term is 'Journeys' and we will be finding out about the lives of Neil Armstrong and Christopher Columbus. The children will use their history, geography, art and DT skills to learn about and represent the life, times and events of these historical figures.

Science

During our science lessons, we will be learning about health and growth and the uses of everyday materials. Computing
