



2019-20 Projected spend and impact summary

Statistics

In school approximately 14% (29) of our children are entitled to benefit from the additional PP funding.

In the current year (2019/20) the school receives £ 33, 180 additional funds.

Strategy for using the funding

The school has looked carefully at the needs of each pupil and we have decided to spend the money accordingly as detailed below:

- Employ a Family Support Worker to engage with families that are vulnerable or are in need of advice or support. To liaise with PWO to support families with the importance of punctuality and maximum attendance at school. To liaise with external services to support pupils who needs that can be helped by specialised external agencies. **£24,000**
- To provide opportunities for PP to attend music lessons **£400**
- To provide opportunities for PP to attend breakfast and after school club **£600**
- Support for extra provisions , outings, clothing, uniforms, mental wellbeing resources, IT resources, **£1,680**
- Professional Development/Remote learning **£2,000**
- Small world play resources/books for Communication and language support **£1,500**
- TA support across the key stages **£3,000**
