## Swimming Results 2023/24

Swimming is a national curriculum requirement and by the end of key Stage 2, pupils are expected to be able to swim confidently and know how to be safe in and around water.

The 3 national curriculum requirements for swimming and water safety are to:

- swim competently, confidently and proficiently over a distance of at least 25 metres
- perform a safe self-rescue in different water based situations
- use a range of strokes effectively

Schools are required to publish information on the percentage of their pupils in Year 6 who met each of the three swimming and water safety national curriculum requirements.

In St Bernadette's school, we start swimming lessons in Year 3. In doing so our children, from a younger age, have more opportunities to reach the target. Children who have not met the expected requirement are then able to continue with swimming lessons throughout Years 4, 5 and 6.
