- ✦ **The Book People Book Fair - Wednesday 6th March - Tuesday 11th March** at the end of the school day (letter to follow)
- ✦ **A Book at Bedtime** - in school, on **Thursday 7th March**. Reception/KS1 children can return to school, with their parents, at **6pm**, with teddies and in their PJs, for a milky drink and bedtime stories. Parents are welcome to stay in the hall, with refreshments, whilst the children go into their own class until finish at 6.30pm (letter to follow)
- ✦ **World Book Day /Character Day** - on **Thursday 7th March**, children can dress as a character from their favourite story book (KS2 children should be ready to answer questions about their character in front of selected judges).
- ✦ **Prizes** - books will be awarded to the most imaginative character in Reception/KS1. Judges will be awarding books to those in KS2 who can bring their character alive
- ✦ **Book swap stall - Friday 8th March**. Children can bring in their own (good quality) books and permanently exchange them at a stall run by Year 6 children. Please send in any books by **Wednesday 6th March**
- ✦ **An Author visit** - Dan Worsley will come into school on **Friday 8th March** to deliver writing workshops (letter to follow)
- ✦ **Non-uniform day - Friday 8th March**. Your donation of £1 will also include a cake during morning break - donations of cakes are most welcome too! We will also sell cakes after school in the new hall at **3.30pm**.

We hope the activities and events organised will be full of creativity and learning for our children!
