Dear Parent/Carer,

We hope your child has enjoyed their instrumental lessons this year. In order for us to ensure we have adequate tuition time for the next academic year, we need to know if they would like to continue with their lessons.

Lessons will take place in school time (at lunch time or during the afternoon). As previously, any child who learns an instrument will be expected to take good care of their instrument, remember to bring it in every week and practise daily at home.

There will be a slight increase in price to £5 per lesson, payable half termly. It has been a number of years since we have increased our prices, and we do not like to do so, however it is now a necessity. These still compare favourably to the normal cost for a 20 minute lesson with a private music teacher. The standard charge would be in the region of £10 per lesson.

The expectation would be that your child continues lessons for the whole school year. However, if your child chooses not to, you must give one whole term's notice to the office and pay for lessons during the notice period.
