Dear Parents,

We begin our Sports Days week beginning the 10th June. We would like to let you know about arrangements, especially for all our new parents.

Infants Sports Day: Tuesday 18th June 2019

Infants Sports events will take place in the morning. The activities will run from 9.15am until 10.00am approximately. Children will assemble on the MUGA at 9.15am. Mrs Satterthwaite will welcome parents and officially commence the activities. Children will proceed onto the field in their teams. There will be a parents viewing area in the centre of the field. This will make it possible for parents to move around and follow their children as they move through the activities. If you drop your children off at school at 8.45am onwards, there will be coffee and tea available for parents in the school hall from 9am, once the children have come into their classrooms.

Children will bring their PE kits home on **Monday 17th June** so that they can come into school the following day in their PE kits, ready for the day. They will be able to stay in their kits all day - Please ensure that all children have white shorts/ white T shirt and black pumps.

Please could we ask that ALL parents stay in the viewing area during the sports activities to avoid teachers losing sight of any pupils.

Junior Sports Day: Thursday 13th June 2019

Junior Sports events will start at 9.15am and Mrs Pearson will welcome parents and officially open the proceedings. This first session will comprise of 'House-team events at 9.15am - 10.00am. There will then be a short break when parents will be asked to come in to the school hall for coffee/tea to allow the playground to be available for the infants to have their playtime. At 10.30am the **pupils who are involved**, will take part in relays, individual sprints and long distance finals. Could parents please **not** encourage their children to leave their class groups as this makes it very difficult for staff to monitor their whereabouts.

Children will bring their PE kits home on **Wednesday 12th June** so that they can come into school the following day in their PE kits, ready for the day. They will be able to stay in their kits all day - Please ensure that all children have white shorts/t-shirt and trainers (no joggers, please).
