Dear Parent/Carer,

Your child has shown an interest in learning to play the violin or guitar. Lessons take place in school time (at lunch time or during the afternoon) and will be subject to audition, should we have too many applicants. Any child who is successful in gaining a place will be expected to take good care of their instrument, remember to bring it in every week and practise daily at home.

There will be a charge of £5 per lesson, payable half termly. This compares very favourably to the normal cost for a 20 minute lesson with a private music teacher. The standard charge would be in the region of £10 per lesson. The expectation would be that your child continues lessons for the whole school year. However, if your child chooses not to, you must give one whole term's notice to the office and pay for lessons during the notice period.

Should auditions be necessary, they will be held over the next few weeks. If you would like your child to learn one of these instruments from September, please complete and return the reply slip below to Mrs Salisbury by Wednesday 19th June.
