Dear Parents/Carers,

I am writing to officially inform you that we have a positive case of COVID-19 that has an impact on your child's bubble - Year 1 and Year 5.

The latest guidance issued to schools by Public Health England states -

"The Head Teacher or appropriate member of the leadership team at the educational setting will be asked to work with the contact tracer to identify direct and close contacts of the case during the 48 hours prior to the child or staff member falling ill. This is likely to be the classmates and teacher of that class. The social distancing measures put in place by educational settings outside the classroom should reduce the number of other direct/close contacts.

All direct and close contacts will be excluded from school and advised to self-isolate for 14 days starting from the day they were last in contact with the case.

Household members of contacts do not need to self-isolate "unless the contact develops symptoms."

This means that as advised by the Local Authority, we will be closing the class bubbles and your child will therefore need to self-isolate (to return 2nd December). Your child does not need to get a COVID-19 test unless they develop symptoms (fever/dry cough/loss of taste or smell) and members of your household are not required to self-isolate. Any siblings in school, in other classes, do not need to isolate and are fine to attend school unless they develop symptoms. Please contact the school if your child falls ill whilst self-isolating.

Your child will be set work on the 'Google Classroom 'by your class teacher. You also have 'Purple Mash' that you can access. If you do not feel confident with either of these on-line resources, your child also took home a pack, earlier in the term, with work that they can complete. They bring the completed set work back to school when they return. 
