We are very pleased to inform you that during this Summer Term, children from Years 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6 will be taking part in our new 'Forest School' sessions. Year's Reception and Year 1 will start their sessions in September. Kate Topping, a teacher and qualified Forest School leader, will be running the sessions. Our Forest School sessions will be organised in 6-week blocks and last approximately 1 hour. They will take place in the school grounds, within a designated area, that the children will be taking ownership of. The safety and the welfare of the pupils participating in Forest School is paramount and therefore all tasks are age-appropriate and risk assessments will be carried out for all activities prior to taking place.
