Dear Parents/ Carers,

As part of our Science topic and with links to English, we have arranged for Year 1 and year 2 to visit Farmer Parrs on Monday 11th July 2022. The visit will reinforce the children's learning in class and involve going around the farm and an educational animal talk. The sessions are interactive and usually include live animals and artefacts.

We are asking for a voluntary contribution of £10.00, per child, to cover all the costs of entry and the coach, please pay this via parent pay. School are subsidising some of the money as coaches are very expensive due to the current price of fuel. The visit will take place within the school day. Children will wear their school uniform (including their school jumper/cardigan with our school badge for easy identification) and school shoes. Please ensure they have a waterproof coat and a sunhat whatever the weather in the morning. Please apply sun cream before they come into school.

As Year 1 and Year 2 children can have a free school meal, our kitchen is able to provide them with a packed lunch. I have already asked the children what filling they would like on their sandwich. The packed lunch comes with a drink, a piece of fruit and either a biscuit or a cake.

If your child is asthmatic and they do not have an inhaler in school please send one in with their name on. Please let me know of any other medical issues I need to be aware of particularly as they may be handling animals.
