Welcome back everyone. I hope you have all had some sort of normality over Christmas and the New year, although I do know from families that it has been tricky. Thankfully, we have all staff in school and we pray that this continues so we can deliver face to face teaching.

We have not made any drastic changes to our procedures in school following the new guidelines:

- No bubbles, things remain the same
- Parents can enter the playground as normal
- We will continue to limit visitors into school
- All visitors will take a Lateral Flow test before they enter the building
- Breakfast and After School clubs will return to their building
- NO whole school assemblies until the end of January then we will reassess
- Class Mass' will go ahead as we can limit the amount of children we have in the hall
- After School Clubs to go ahead as normal
- Ventilation and hygiene still remains a priority and our procedures are already in place
- Extra cleaning procedures will remain
- Primary children and staff are not required to wear face coverings but staff may wear a face covering in corridors or communal areas.
- Staff will continue to be vigilant and keep their distance from children/ adults wherever possible.
