As the children have settled back into school, our priority has been establishing new routines, checking on well-being, and assessing gaps in knowledge.

As in the previous academic year, teachers will be making a phone call (next week) to those parents whose children have been invited to attend the after school catch-up. As part of our recovery programme, we also have regular intervention programmes, with groups of children, throughout the school day. If your child is involved in these support groups, your child's teacher will be contacting you to discuss.

We will shortly be sending out dates for the autumn term teacher conference meetings. Further information will follow as to whether these will be face to face, zoom or telephone meetings.

The meetings will provide you with the opportunity to discuss how your child has settled back into school, progress and subsequent support that may have been put in place.
