

Jimmy Armfield Football Tournament

Dear Parent(s) / Carer(s)

In preparation for the Jimmy Armfield Tournament on Monday 8th July, please read the below information related to the event.

What to bring for the event

Your child will come home today with a school football kit to wear to the event on Monday. This will consist of a top, shorts and a pair of socks. They may also bring home a pair of shin pads. Your child should arrive at the event wearing our school football kit. They will also need appropriate footwear for football. Studs are permitted, however these should be plastic, not metal. Your child will also need to bring a water bottle, sun hat (weather dependant) and may want a jacket. A healthy snack or fruit can also be brought.

Please be aware that without shin pads your child will be unable to play.

- All kit and borrowed items will be returned to Mr. Hopkinson after the event.

What to bring for after the event

Your child will also need to bring their school uniform to change into upon their return to school. This should be the right attire typically required on a Monday for your child's class. Additionally, children will need to bring their packed lunches, water bottles, diaries.

A member of staff will take lunch orders for those children on a school lunch and pass these onto our office staff. Lunch will be eaten upon the children's return to school.

Inhalers and First Aid

For children that have inhalers in school, staff will bring them on the day. First Aid, if required, will be administered by staff.

Staff (Mrs Freitas and Mrs McAdams) will be on site for around 9:15am and will wait for all children at the **red circle** indicated on the map (north of the playground and south of where the trampoline park used to be) in their purple staff uniform. Once all children are present, they will make their way to the 3g pitches for registration.
