I am writing to remind you regarding our upcoming outdoor adventure at **Brockholes Nature Reserve**, Preston. Our trip will take place on **Friday 28<sup>th</sup> June 2024**. The children will be taking part in two workshops as we explore the nature reserve: Pond Dipping and Mini-Beasts. It promises to be a fun-filled and exciting day for the children!

### Visit Details:

**Location:** Brockholes Nature Reserve, Preston, PR5 0AG

**Date:** Friday 28<sup>th</sup> June 2024

**Departure:** 9:10 am (approx.)

**Return:** 3pm (approx.)

To ensure a 10am arrival, children will need to arrive at school for 8:30am to allow sufficient time for toileting and registration before departure. I will collect children from the office direct them to the main hall.

### Essential information for the visit:

- Children will need to bring a water bottle for the visit.
- As this is an outdoor experience, children should anticipate getting muddy and wet. Therefore, children should wear appropriate clothing for the day and bring water-proofs and wellies in a separate bag.
  - Light clothing is advised due to the time of year (e.g. joggers / leggings and t-shirt/long-sleeved top would be fine underneath waterproof jacket).
  - A sunhat.
  - Sun cream should be applied before coming to school.
  - Children may need a carrier bag to put any dirty clothing/waterproofs into.
