As you are aware, the children will sit their end of KS2 SATs next week. The children have been working hard, all year, ready to prepare them so they are able to showcase the knowledge and skills learnt throughout their time at St Bernadette's.

It is hoped the tests will be used to provide important data on children's attainment. The information will also ensure the secondary schools are able to support our young people as they move on from primary school.

Test Results:

You will receive test results with your child's end of school report in English reading, English grammar, punctuation and spelling and mathematics. There is no test for English writing; this will be reported using teacher assessment.

You will be given your child's scaled score and whether they have reached the expected standard set by the Department for Education ('NS' means that the expected standard was not achieved and 'AS' means the expected standard was achieved). There will also be teacher assessment information; children working at - entering, developing, secure and greater depth.

I also want to remind parents that this is a '**moment in time**' for our fabulous children. We know that throughout their time in St Bernadette's that we have kind and passionate children who have a full life ahead of them to explore their talents and interests.
