We have had a busy couple of weeks!

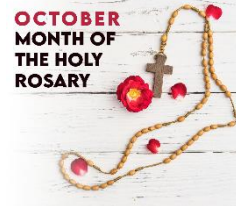
A huge congratulations to our football team for a win against Revoe in their cup match.

School Admissions

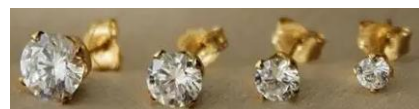
A reminder that the deadline for applying for High School places for next year closes on 31st October 2025.
