Well done to the following superstars. You have all shone brightly and impressed your teachers. We are very proud of you!

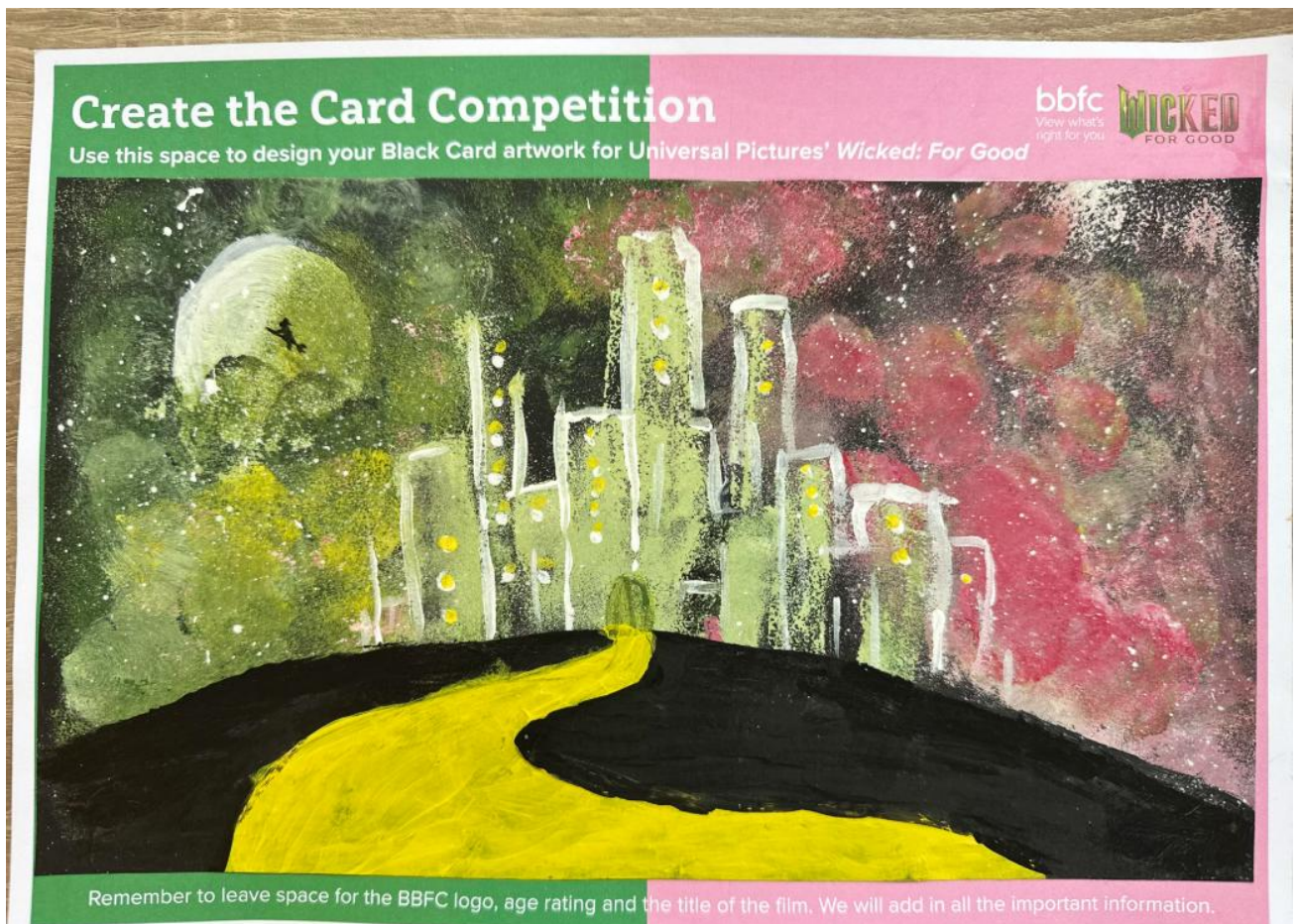
