

# **Checklist for Admissions September 2026**

If your child will turn 11 between 1 September 2025 and 31 August 2026, they will transfer to secondary school at the start of the new school year in September 2026.

Before applying for a Y7 place, parents must read the booklets produced by Wigan Council and St Helens Council (depending on where you live) as it contains important information about the application process.

The closing date for applications is 31 October 2025

#### **HOW TO APPLY**

### **Wigan Borough Residents:**

- The online application will open on 12 September 2025
- You will need to apply online using the Citizen Portal
- If you have previously used the citizen portal to apply for a school place, you can log in using the same email and password. If you don't already have an account on the Citizen Portal, you will need to click on 'register an account'.
- You can make changes to your online application form as many times as you like up to the closing date on 31 October 2025.
- The citizen portal may ask for your child's Unique Identification Number (UID) when you apply, you can ask your child's primary school for this number (Wigan primary schools only). You can still apply without the UID number. If the Admissions Portal does not ask for your UID it means that your child's details have automatically been matched to their record and you won't need to enter it.

### St Helens Borough Residents:

- From Monday 2 September the website: <a href="www.sthelens.gov.uk/admissions">www.sthelens.gov.uk/admissions</a> is open for parents who wish to apply online.
- The closing date for you to submit your application is 31 October 2025
- You will be notified on 3 March 2026 confirming your child's school place.
- Before submitting your application, please read the Secondary Admissions Booklet which contains all the vital information about the application process.
- Also, consider how your child will get to school and the potential <u>Can I apply for assistance with transport to school?</u> costs.
